STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

1. I, hereby agree to breed my mare _____ Reg. No. _____ to Bugs Valentino - AQHA # 3538187 for the _____ season at \$_____. A check for \$ _____ made payable to stallion owner _____, along with a copy of the mare's registration papers (front and back) must be returned with this contract (completed and signed) to Don Ham Quarter Horses. The \$_____ will be a **booking fee** and will hold the right of the mare owner to one breeding during the _____ breeding season. The **booking fee** is non-refundable. A \$ _____ non-refundable chute fee is due and payable to Don Ham Quarter Horses before or upon the mare's arrival at the breeding facility. **The balance of the stallion fee \$ _____ will be due upon departure of the mare from the breeding facility.** No mare will be bred before the booking fee and chute fee have been paid and a completed contract is on file.

2. All other expenses, including board, vet expenses, farrier (if necessary), etc. will be due monthly. All accounts thirty days past due will be assessed a finance charge of 1.5% per month. **All bills will be paid in full before the mare will be allowed to depart the breeding facility.**

3. Live foal guaranteed with return privilege the following season by stallion owner only if mare fails to produce a live foal after being sent home in foal. It is understood that should the foal not stand and nurse, mare owner will be entitled to a return privilege the following year only. This guarantee applies only if mare owner notifies stallion owner within one week from death of a foal. This notice must accompany by a statement from a licensed veterinarian. If the mare is to be returned and the mare owner fails to deliver her for rebreeding the following year, then any and all fees shall not be refundable and this contract is thereby cancelled. **If the mare should fail to become pregnant, lose the pregnancy or the foal dies; another chute fee will be due prior to the mare being rebred the following year. If the mare dies or becomes unfit for breeding, the mare owner may return the following year with a substitute mare approved in advance by the stallion owner.**

4. Diligent efforts will be made to impregnate the mare. However, if for any reason she does not become pregnant, the mare owner will not hold the stallion owner, Don Ham Quarter Horses and/or their representatives liable. It is the mare owner's responsibility to have the mare pregnancy checked within 15 days of departure from the breeding facility. Don Ham Quarter Horses must be notified in writing of the mare's current status. A pregnancy status form will be sent with the mare at departure. If Don Ham Quarter Horses is not notified of the mare's status, another booking fee will be due prior to the mare being rebred the following year. The breeding season will begin February 1st and close July 15th. Mare owner agrees to leave mare at Don Ham Quarter Horses until the mare has had a 30-40 day positive pregnancy exam or as otherwise agreed to by mare owner and Don Ham Quarter Horses.

5. It is understood that should the above named stallion die, or become unfit for service, this contract shall become null and void and the breeder's fee will be refunded.

6. A "Breeder's Certificate" will be issued upon notification of the birth of the foal by the stallion owner.

7. All mares must have proof of a current negative Coggins test and be current on all vaccinations and deworming within 30 days prior to arrival at the breeding facility. If mare arrives without proof of negative Coggins and/or vaccination/deworming dates, it will be done upon arrival and at mare owner's expense by the attending veterinarian. Each mare will receive a mandatory strep shot upon arrival. Mare owner agrees that the breeding manager and/or their veterinarian may examine the mare for normal breeding conditions and to perform such other services as deemed necessary at mare owner's expense.

8. Mare owner understands and agrees that neither stallion owner, Don Ham Quarter Horses and/or their representatives will be held responsible for accidents, sickness or death to the mare and/or foal. Furthermore, mare owner agrees that the above named parties shall not be held liable for any negligence or errors and that the above named parties may exercise their judgement in supervising and caring for mares and foals. The above names parties assume no liability for mare owners.

9. If this contract is for transported cooled semen, a transported semen information form must be completed and returned to Don Ham Quarter Horses prior to the first shipment of semen. In addition, the stallion fee payable to the stallion owner is due in full along with the transportation semen fee payable to Don Ham Quarter Horses before shipment.
